The event brought together students and faculty members from various institutions across the Asia- Pacific region, providing a dynamic platform to showcase business acumen and technical expertise.

A team comprising five students and two faculty members represented the institution in this prestigious competition. The participants actively engaged in the ERPsim Manufacturing Sustainability Game with Disruptors, a simulation-based learning experience designed to enhance decision-making skills in a competitive business environment.

During the competition, students applied their knowledge of business strategies, operations, and sustainability concepts to manage a virtual company. They were required to make critical decisions related to production planning, pricing strategies, procurement, and financial management. These decisions were executed in real-time using SAP S/4HANA integrated with SAP Fiori applications, providing a hands-on experience of enterprise resource planning systems.

The simulation emphasised sustainability and disruption in manufacturing, encouraging participants to balance profitability with environmental and social considerations. The interactive nature of the game enabled students to understand the complexities of real-world business scenarios and the importance of data-driven decision-making.
